Rules of Operation of the Dance Hall

Starý svět, zájezdní hostinec, s.r.o. Amerika č.p.9, 259 01 Votice

By accepting the key to the Dance Hall, the visitor confirms that he/she has read the Rules of Operation and agrees with their content and agrees to abide by them.

a) General rules

Article I. Entry to the Dance Hall

1) The Dance Hall area includes:

Dance hall, Whirlpool, sauna (Potírna) and swimming pool (Koupadlo)

The operating hours of the Dance hall are as follows:

Dance Hall by individual arrangement (but only between 6:00-22:00)

Potírna and Whirlpool 11:00-21:30

Koupadlo 11:00-21:30

Monday is a sanitation and maintenance day.

An individual change of the morning times for using the services of the Dance Hall must be discussed and agreed upon with the manager beforehand (this also applies to the possible opening of the premises on a sanitary day - Monday).

2) **The Dance Hall area** is accessible to guests by arrangement with reception staff. Other people may use the premises on a reservation basis, except for the Tub, which is reserved for guests.

The payment for the use of the individual parts of the Dance Hall is set as follows:

- 1) for guests:
- Koupadlo for free
- Potírna, Whirlpool and Dance Hall for a fee
- 2) for non-guests:
- Potírna, Whirlpool and Dance Hall after prior reservation for a fee

The price of services is available at the reception of the restaurant.

- 3) Entrance to the Dance Hall area is prohibited for:
 - people affected by fever, conjunctivitis, skin or communicable diseases, parasites, rashes, etc.
 - persons in quarantine for infection
 - persons who are polluted, intoxicated or under the influence of other intoxicants
 - animals
 - people who disrespect in any way the operating rules and do not follow the instructions of the service manager



Article II. Rights and obligations of visitors

- 1) Each visitor agrees to use all services within the Dance Hall at his/her own risk and responsibility when accepting a key from the Dance Hall premises.
- 2) Each visitor is obliged to maintain personal cleanliness and to keep clean all places and facilities within the premises and to ensure the safety of himself and others in his actions.
- 3) Any found objects that are not part of the premises must be handed over to the manager or bar staff at the restaurant.
- 4) Visitors are obliged to respect the entire area of the Dance Hall. They are obliged to pay for damages or losses caused by their fault both to the premises and to the property of other persons.
- 5) There is an increased risk of slipping in the Dance Hall area, so each visitor is required to move slowly and cautiously to prevent injury to themselves or others.
- 6) Visitors are obliged to respect the times for which they rented the premises. They are also obliged to respect the maximum number of people for whom the facility is intended and rented.
- 7) Towels, bath towels and exercise mats are available for a fee from the staff. (list of the rental proces is available at the reception).

Article III. It is forbidden in the whole area of the Sports Hall

- smoking and manipulating with open fire
- behave in a manner that endangers, restricts or disturbs other visitors
- to pollute the playground and surroundings by spitting, littering, etc.
- bring in any objects that threaten or restrict other visitors (glass, etc.)

b) Rules of individual parts of the premises

Article IV. Ballroom (Dance Hall)

- 1) Entrance to the ballroom is only allowed barefoot, in socks or dancing shoes (for ladie's dancing shoes, use heel protectors (available from the manager). No outdoor shoes are allowed on the dance floor.
- 2) All the equipment (lighting, sound) will be used by the visitors exactly according to the instructions of the manager of the operation and will be put back to its original state after the end of the activity in the ballroom.

Article V. Sauna (Potírna)

The Potírna is a hot-air sauna with air temperature between 75-90 C and a very low relative humidity of 10-15 %. The rules for visiting the sauna are given in the attachment of those Rules of Operation.



Article VI. Whirlpool

The Whirlpool is a massage tub with several different massage jets and a water temperature of about 37 C. The rules for visitors to the Hot Tub are given in the attachment of those Rules of Operation.

Article VII. Koupadlo

The Koupadlo is a natural saltwater pool.

The rules for visitors of the Koupadlo are given in the attachment of those Rules of Operation.

c) Common provisions

Article VIII. Drinks

Consumption of beverages in glass in the whole area of the Dance Hall is forbidden without prior approval of the manager.

Article IX. Injuries

In case of injury or sickness, it is necessary to call the manager of the restaurant or the bar staff and provide first aid. The injury and the damage sustained must be reported on the day on which it occurred so that the circumstances under which the damage to health occurred can be properly and timely ascertained and investigated. The visitor undertakes to provide the operator with the cooperation necessary to ascertain all decisive facts necessary to assess liability for the damage caused. The operator shall not be liable for any ascertainment of decisive facts if the damage to health has not been reported in accordance with the foregoing or if the visitor has not fulfilled his obligation to provide such assistance.

The visitor is aware that the operator is not obliged to accept and carry out the necessary investigations to clarify the damage after the notification of accidents and damage.

The operator shall not be held liable for injuries and accidents caused by the visitor's own carelessness or failure to comply with this order.

Article X. Visitor's personal belongings

The operator is not liable for loss or damage to the visitor.

For the storage of money and valuable items (laptops, cell phones, watches, valuable ornaments, etc.), a safe is available to visitors, which is operated by the reception staff of the inn.

In case of loss of personal belongings, you must immediately inform the reception, who will make a record and call the police if necessary.



Article XI. Exclusion from the Dance Hall

Any visitor who, despite being warned, fails to comply with the provisions of these operating rules or disobeys the instructions of the operator (or the head of the operation) or behaves in any other improper manner will be banned from the premises.

Article IX. Liability for damages

The Operator shall be entitled to invoice the visitor for any damages to the full extent caused by the failure to comply with these operating instructions and all other rules published on the website of the STARY SVĚT zájezdní hostinec and municipally binding regulations.

Article X. Changes

The operator reserves the right to change the operating hours.
